## THE CAREER

Individuals who have a degree or certificate in Computer Technology are eligible for positions in information management, system analysis and design, applications, operation and programming, as well as supervisory positions.

## CAREER OPTIONS

TCL offers a two-year academic Associate Degree in Computer Technology and a variety of Computer Technology Certificates including Computer Applications, Help Desk Management, Programming, Database, Multimedia Design, and Webmaster. Individuals in this field can expect to earn from \$23,937 to \$61,775 annually in the Beaufort area.

## PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Computer Technology program is designed to prepare graduates for entry-level positions in information management. From entry-level positions opportunities exist for advancement into system analysis and design, applications, operation and programming, and supervisory positions.
