THE PROGRAM

This program prepares students for transfer into allied health fields. These may include: nursing, massage therapy, radiology technology, surgical technology and physical therapist assistant.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Pre-Allied Health Studies certificate program provides students interested in allied health careers with academic skills and prerequisite instruction to meet admission criteria and ensure opportunity for transfer of appropriate courses into applicable allied health certificate and diploma programs.

ADMISSIONS

Applicants interested in the Pre-Allied Health must first complete the college application process. After the college admission process has been completed, the prospective student makes an appointment to meet with a Health Science advisor.
