	3. Verify official transcripts, from high school (or GED) and all colleges previously attended have been received by TCL. NOTE: It is the student's responsibility to follow up with Student Records for transfer of credits.
	4. Biophysical science course credits and mathematics course credits must be earned within seven years of admission to any Health Sciences program.
	5. Must be eligible to take MAT 120 and BIO 211 prior to entry into the program.
	6. Have you met face-to-face with a Health Sciences advisor within six months of application submission? Circle Yes or No
	7. Must submit a copy of a valid LPN license at the time of application.
	8. Advanced placement applicants must be Licensed Practical Nurses, successfully complete BIO 210 and PSY 201, and meet the following criteria: 1. a. Score at least a 63 (adjusted individual total score) on the TEAS V or ATI TEAS (may be Kaplan Admission Test) and have a b. TCL GPA \geq 2.50 or If student has not attended TCL, GPA from last college attended must be \geq 2.50 or c. Minimum high school GPA of 2.50 if no college attended. 2. Score at least 1300 on the Achieve 3000. (Contact the Tutoring Center for an appointment) The TEAS test may only be taken three times within a 12 month period from date of first test. Only the highest score will be considered. Copies of ALL TEAS Test Results must be included (not just those taken within the past 12 months). 	9. Applicants with two or more failures (D, F, WF) in required non-nursing courses (BIO 210, BIO 211, BIO 225, ENG 101, ENG 102, MAT 120, PSY 201, or PSY 203) within the last three years must: a. Score at least a 66 (adjusted individual total score) on the TEAS V or ATI TEAS (may be Kaplan Admission Test) and; b. Complete all required non-nursing courses in the program of study (BIO 210, BIO 211, BIO 225, ENG 101, ENG 102, MAT 120, PSY 201, PSY 203, and 3 hours of an approved humanities course) and a TCL GPA \geq 2.75. If student has not attended TCL, GPA from last college attended must be \geq 2.75. Math and biology courses must have been completed within the last seven years.

	<p>OR</p> <p>Applicants with two or more failures (D, F, WF) in Nursing courses have one opportunity for admission. Applicant must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Score 70 or greater (adjusted individual total score) on the TEAS V or ATI TEAS and, Complete all non-Nursing courses in the program of study (BIO 210, BIO 211, BIO 225, ENG 101, ENG 102, MAT 120, PSY 201, PSY 203 and 3 hours of an approved humanities course) with a TCL GPA \geq 2.75. Math courses must be completed within the last seven years. Biology courses must be completed within 24 months from the date of application. Wait a minimum of three academic years from the time of second failure to apply.
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> I understand that if accepted into the program: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> I must maintain a TCL GPA of at least 2.50 to enter the program. I must complete the Achieve 3000 with a score of 1300. I must attend the entire mandatory orientation and all required activities as stated in my acceptance letter. I must have access to a computer, webcam, microphone and internet as all nursing courses have an online component. I must be able to attend clinical rotations at sites within a 60 mile radius of the Beaufort or New River campus which may include weekend and evening rotations. I must be eligible and able to attend all clinical sites utilized by the Nursing Program. I will be required to attend Nursing classes at the Beaufort campus as not all Nursing classes are offered at the New River campus. I will be required to complete a drug screen and background check. If I have concerns about results that may be present on my background check, I must schedule a meeting with the Dean upon receiving my acceptance letter. I will be required to provide health information and complete clinical information for various agencies at admission and throughout the program. I will be required to provide documentation of valid health insurance for the duration of the program.
