Purpose:

The purpose of this procedure is to define the classification categories for students being admitted to the College.

Procedure:

Students are identified according to the following classifications:

- 1. New Student
 - a. First time: A student entering a curriculum program for the first time at an institution of higher education. First-time students may have completed dual enrollment course work while attending high school.
 - b. Transfer: A student transferring from an institution of higher education.
 - c. Dual Enrollment: A student enrolled at the College and is also receiving high school credit. These students must follow the State Guidelines for dual enrollment.
 - d. Early High School Graduates: A student graduating from high school midacademic year.
- 2. Continuing Student
 - a. Continuing: A currently enrolled student continuing in the same program of study.
- 3. Returning Student
 - a. Readmit: A student who has not been enrolled in classes at the College for three (3) consecutive semesters.
- 4. Special Categories
 - a. Transient: A student taking a course or courses to transfer back to the institution in which they are enrolled, without acceptance into a specific curriculum. They must submit a transient form completed by the primary institution in which they are enrolled in order to register for class(es) at the College

b. Senior Citizen: A student who has attained the age of 60 and meet the eligibility requirements in accordance with the South Carolina Code of Laws for a Senior Citizen Tuition Waiver taking a course(es) at the College.
