Purpose:

This procedure outlines the process by which legal residents of South Carolina who have attained the age of 60 may enroll in classes and apply for eligibility for a Senior Citizen Tuition Waiver in accordance with the South Carolina Code of Laws.

Procedure:

Individuals meeting the requisite age and residency requirements may attend class for credit or audit purposes on a space available basis without the required payment of tuition provided they do not receive compensation as full-time employees. Courses offered through the Continuing Education Division are not offered on a tuition-free basis. Persons attending classes under the provisions of this Act shall neither be counted in the enrollment computation for funding purposes nor considered on a formula basis for the issuance of capital improvement bonds.

Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. The individual must be a legal resident of South Carolina and have attained the age of 60.
- 2. The individual must not receive compensation as a full-time employee.
- 3. The individual must meet course admissions requirements.
- 4. The class must have met the minimum class size required, excluding senior citizen enrollment.
- 5. The class size must be below maximum size.

Registration Process:

- 1. A senior citizen is required to complete an online Application for Admission.
- 2. Senior citizens may obtain a Senior Citizen Tuition Waiver Form from the Student

Records Electronic Form page. A South Carolina Driver's License, or South Carolina state identification card must be presented.

- 3. Senior citizen students may only be registered within the last week of open registration before the start of a semester. Registration must be completed by the Registrar's Office.
- 4. Upon completion of the registration and determination of eligibility by the Registrar's Office, senior citizen students will have tuition waived and fees assessed.
- 5. There is no charge for tuition, but college fees still apply.
- 6. The student is responsible for purchasing textbooks and all other materials or supplies required for the courses.
- 7. Senior citizens choosing to pay as a regular student to reserve a class seat will not be granted a refund if they choose later to apply as a senior citizen.
