Purpose:

This procedure discusses residency classification for the purpose of tuition and fees.

Procedure:

Residency classification for the purpose of tuition and fees is determined by Admissions at the time an applicant submits an application for admission to the Technical College of the Lowcountry in accordance with the Code of Laws of South Carolina 1976, Sections 59-112-10 through 59-112-150. Guidelines are established by the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education and administered by the College.

Applicants or students may request a review of their residency classification by completing the Residency Reclassification form and submission of official supporting documentation. Admissions staff reviews and makes residency determinations in accordance with the regulations provided by the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education.

An applicant or a student may appeal a residency reclassification decision that will be reviewed by the Residency Appeals Committee. Decisions of the Committee are final.
