In academic programs where there is a set limit to the number of students who can be admitted, first preference for admission to these programs will be given to applicants who meet program criteria and reside within the four-county service area. Second preference will be given to applicants who are South Carolina residents, meet program criteria, and reside outside of the four-county service area, and to residents of Chatham and Effingham counties in Georgia who meet the program criteria. Final preference for admission will be given to out-of-state applicants who meet the program criteria.
