Explore beautiful cities, rural towns and countryside

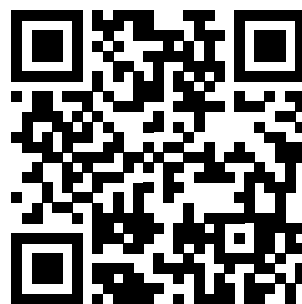
