

Clinical Obligation

Clinical rotations will begin after the fourth week of the fall semester. Students will need to have successfully completed the following to be eligible for clinical rotations:

1. A comprehensive health form that includes documentation of required immunizations and physical
2. Purchase immunization tracker Complio
3. 2-step PPD or Quantiferon Gold
4. Successful background check
5. Successful passing on drug screen
6. BLS CPR certification for Healthcare Workers (must be maintained throughout the program)
7. Professional Liability Insurance
8. Personal Medical Insurance
9. Purchase Castle Branch Bridges

Clinical Objectives

Students will rotate in a different facility each semester in order to receive a very well-rounded clinical experience and education. These locations are dispersed no more than 60 miles from the Beaufort Mather Campus. Imaging settings include: hospitals, level 1 trauma center, outpatient services and specialty modalities. Students may have evening and weekend assignments. Students will be required to complete exams per the ARRT specifications. Each semester there will be objectives assigned to correlate with learning opportunities in the clinical setting.
