## Medical Assisting - Application Checklist

## Application Checklist

$\square$ My official TCL admission application is on file
Note - It is necessary to reapply if you have not attended classes at TCL for >1 year
$\square$ I have verified that official transcripts from high school (or GED) and all colleges previously attended have been received by TCL.

Note - It is the student's responsibility to follow-up with Student Records for transfer of credits
$\square \quad$ I am eligible to take BIO 112
$\square$ My biophysical science course credits were completed within five years of admission
$\square$ I have met with my Health Sciences advisor or attended a Health Sciences Information Session

## Application Requirements

$\square \quad$ Pathway 1 - Students who do not need increased requirements under Pathway 2
$\square \quad$ I have an institutional GPA of 2.25 or higher from the last college attended
Note - If no college credits have been earned, minimum high school GPA of 2.25 is required.
$\square$ Pathway $\mathbf{2}$ - Required for applicants that have failures (D/F/WF) within the last three years in two or more required general education courses
$\square$ I have an institutional GPA of 2.5 or higher from the last college attended.

## Acknowledgements

I understand that if accepted into the program:
$\square$ I must maintain a TCL GPA of at least 2.00 to remain in program.
$\square \quad$ I must attend the entire mandatory orientation and all required activities as stated in my acceptance letter.
$\square$ I must have access to a computer, webcam, microphone, and internet as all MA courses have an online component.
$\square$ I must be able to attend clinical rotations at sites within a 60-mile radius of the Beaufort campus, which may include weekend and evening rotations.
$\square \quad$ I must be eligible and able to attend all clinical sites utilized by the Medical Assisting program. Clinical clearances are determined by the clinical facilities, not TCL.
$\square \quad$ I will be required to complete a drug screen and background check. If I have concerns about results that may be present on my background check, I must schedule a meeting with the Dean of Health Sciences upon receiving my acceptance letter.
$\square$ I will be required to provide updated health information and complete clinical information for various agencies at admissions and throughout the program.
$\square$ I will be required to provide documentation of valid health insurance for the duration of the program.
$\square$ I must maintain valid AHA BLS certification for the duration of the program.
